Draft regulations will set mandatory marine fuel standard and GHG emissions pricing for shipping to address climate change.

Mandatory for all ships > 5,000 tons from 2028 (~85% of emissions)

Clear **demand signal**providing **regulatory certainty**for industry and fuel providers


Rewarding first-movers and **supporting** developing States

Work ahead: NZF implementing provisions

Substantial further work on implementing provisions and mechanisms ahead of entryinto-force, including on:

- Calculating GFI
- Determining price of 'remedial units'
- Defining the 'reward'
- Defining 'ZNZs'
- Determining Well-to-tank and Tank-to-wake emission factors for fuels/technologies
- Development of IMO's fuel certification framework
- Set-up IMO GFI Registry and IMO Net-Zero Fund
- Assessment of possible impacts on food security


